The Graham County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday November 22, 2016 opening to regular session with the flag salute. Chairman Davignon called the meeting to order with all members and the County Clerk present. Also in attendance was Jason Nelson and April Hofstetter. Minutes of the November 15, 2016 meeting were read. Commissioner Scott made motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Toll seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Hospital

Melissa Atkins, Graham County Hospital Administrator, advised the Commissioners of a leak in the roof at the Hospital. Commissioner Scott made motion to pay Graham County Hospital \$20,000.00 of \$21,160.00 bid to replace the roof on the North central wing of the Hospital to be taken out of the Health Care Sales Tax Fund. Commissioner Toll seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Appraiser

Melanie Rowlinson, Graham County Appraiser, advised Commissioners she will be attending a workshop in Hays on Grain Elevators appraisals.

Miscellaneous

Corina Cox, representing the After Prom Bash, requested donation. Commissioner Toll made motion to approve \$20.00 per student with a total of 33 students, to be taken out of the Special Alcohol Fund. Commissioner Scott seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Tressie Mitzner and Bev Stafford, presented information on starting a community garden on the North side of the Longfellow Middle School building. Setting up an account with the county was discussed. Commissioners preferred the committee to find another means of handling the use of these funds.

Commissioners approved and signed payroll vouchers and checks.

Commissioners signed Landfill statements.

Road & Bridge

Calvin Beckman requested road work done on EE rd. between 170th and 200th Avenue. It was determined that this is Norton County's section of the road to maintain.

As there was no further business to discuss Commissioner Toll made motion to adjourn. Commissioner Davignon seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
