The Graham County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday April 11, 2017 opening to regular session with the flag salute. Chairman Toll called the meeting to order with all members and the Deputy County Clerk present. Minutes of the April 4, 2017 meeting were read. Commissioner Hofstetter made motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

The Graham County Commissioners attended an Emergency Training session beginning at the Emergency Services building and also attended the training that was at the Graham County Hospital in conjunction with Emergency Services.
