

April 18, 2017

The Graham County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday April 18, 2017 opening to regular session with the flag salute. Chairman Toll called the meeting to order with all members and the County Clerk present. Minutes of the April 11, 2017 meeting were read. Commissioner Nelson made motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Hofstetter seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

**Hospital**

Melissa Atkins, Graham County Hospital Administrator, reported on the revenue and expenses of the Hospital. The Audit for the Hospital is completed. The open house for the Wellness Center was successful. The Hospital is continuing interviews for the Radiology Department. The Disaster drill went real good with the Hospital and Emergency Services.

**Miscellaneous**

Bruce VanLoenen wanted to inform the Commissioners about developing and getting bids for a skeet range in Graham County. He advised it would take approximately \$30,000 to get this program going. Bruce advised they are looking at a piece of land located by the ballpark. The city will help with the electricity and the upkeep of the grounds. They are looking into grants and matching funds. Bruce advised there is 90 kids in 4-H and the shooting sports have become real popular.

Commissioner Hofstetter made motion to approve mandatory abatement order #2017000043-#2017000046 with valuation of 10015 and tax dollars of \$1572.72. Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Hofstetter made motion to approve Resolution#2017-08, A Resolution to Adopt the Graham County Credit Card Policy. Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

**Appraiser**

Melanie Rowilson, updated the Commissioners on Real Estate and Personal Property values. Real Estate values should have an increase of about 3,000,000 and Personal Property should have an increase of approximately 70,000. The values from Personal Property are subject to change. Melanie also discussed her contract that is up June 30, 2017. Melanie requested a pay increase. No action taken.

**Road & Bridge**

Wayne Pfeifer, Road and Bridge Supervisor, discussed repairs to trash truck used to haul transfer trash to Garden City. Bridge on 13 mile road was discussed. Commissioners agreed to look at this after lunch.

Recycling at the Landfill was discussed.

As there was no further business to discuss Commissioner Nelson made motion to adjourn. Commissioner Hofstetter seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0
